If your child continues to attend for only 90% of the time that she is at Primary school, she will miss a total of 23 weeks, which is equivalent to over half a school year.

## When attendance falls below 95%

If your child's attendance is below 95%, medical evidence must be provided to support the reason for absence. This includes proof of medical appointments and medication prescribed. Informing the school of an absence does not automatically mean the absence will be authorised. A persistent absence history may influence the absence code.

#### **Persistent Absence**

Persistent Absence is defined as when attendance falls below 90%

Over a year, if your child only has 90% attendance rate means that she has missed the equivalent of four whole weeks of lessons in the school year.

100% Attendance	O days of learning missed	Best chance of success
95% Attendance	2 weeks of learning missed	Poor attendance will impact on learning.
90% Attendance	4 weeks of learning missed	Very poor attendance. You are at risk of prosecution
85% Attendance	5 ½ weeks of learning missed	
80% Attendance	At least 7 ½ weeks of learning missed	

## Unacceptable reasons for absence

- Shopping
- Birthday treats and trips
- Non-urgent medical and dental appointments
- To visit relatives they have not seen for a while
- Siblings were ill
- Parent was ill and could not bring child to school
- Went to bed late
